




# GARBAGE COLLECTION CALENDAR

**Take out combustibles in "specified bags for domestic burnable garbage."**  
**Take out recyclables in "transparent bags"**

Waste category	How to take out garbage
<b>Combustibles</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Kitchen waste and paper waste.</li> <li>•Drain off water from kitchen waste.</li> </ul> 
<b>Metals</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Empty cans of their contents.</li> <li>•Puncture a hole in spray cans.</li> </ul> 
<b>Plastics</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Indicate "マークあり" (With mark) on the garbage bag.</li> <li>•Empty containers of their contents.</li> <li>•Wash out and dry dirty plastics before taking them out.</li> </ul> 
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Indicate "マークなし" (Without mark) on the garbage bag.</li> <li>•Crush plastics into small pieces to fit in a garbage bag.</li> </ul> 
<b>Glass</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Remove the cap/lid from empty glass bottles and crockery.</li> </ul> 
<b>Plastic (PET) bottles</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Take out plastic caps and labels of plastic bottles in a garbage bag indicated "マークあり" (With mark).</li> <li>•Wash out and dry plastic bottles before taking them out.</li> </ul> 
<b>Items that cannot be collected by your local garbage collection site</b>	
<b>Fluorescent lamps</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Please take these items without cracking them.</li> <li>•Fluorescent lamps are not collected as "Glass" waste.</li> <li>•Please take these items to stores that collect these items or a recycle center. *For details, please see our website.</li> </ul> 
<b>Batteries</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Batteries are not collected as "Metal" waste.</li> <li>•Please take these items to Yoshida Town Hall, any of the four community halls, designated stores that collect these items or a recycle center. *For details, please see our website.</li> </ul> 
<b>Used paper</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Take out used paper waste as recyclables or take them directly to a recycle center. (Old newspapers can be taken to any of the four community halls)</li> </ul> 
<b>Small Home Electronic Appliances</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Please take all small home electronic appliances (excluding the four specified categories of electronic appliances) to a recycle center.</li> </ul>

 Make sure to take out your garbage by 8:00 a.m. on the designated collection day.  
 (Do not take out your garbage the night before pickup.)  
 Do not take out your garbage from December 29 to January 3 as there will be no collection service.



## Over-sized waste

Please take oversized waste directly to either center. Some oversized waste may need to be scrapped.



## Five solid items

(pieces of concrete, blocks, roof tiles, bricks and terra-cotta pottery)

For the disposal of pieces of concrete, blocks, roof tiles, bricks and terra-cotta pottery, please contact the Urban Environment Division of the Yoshida Town Hall.  
 \* We do not accept natural materials (such as rocks, soil or sand, etc.).

## Service hours for direct carry-in

Monday through Friday: 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.  
 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.  
 Saturdays (1st and 3rd): 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.  
 Sundays (2nd and 4th): 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.  
 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

While burnable garbage is collected on national holidays and substitute holidays, it cannot be taken to either facility.
